A brief of NSKFDC is enclosed herewith for your kind reference please.

Further, NSKFDC is a MoU Signing PSU from the financial year 2006-07. The targets and parameters of MoU of NSKFDC of each financial year are being fixed by the Task Force Committee constituted by Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) and Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India. As per the MoU for the financial year 2011-12, NSKFDC intends to prepare the Strategic Plan so that the Corporation may able to provide the benefits of the Schemes & Programmes of the Corporation to the targets group more efficiently & effectively in a time bound manner and also to achieve the objectives and mission. The Strategic Plan should include the areas / activities like Loan Sanctioning, Loan Disbursement, Recovery of Dues from SCAs, utilization Loan Disbursement of Skill Development Training, Awareness Camps, Marketing Linkage etc.

ORGANISATION

Incorporated on 24th January, 1997, a company not for profit under Section 25 of the Companies Act, 1956. The Authorised Share Capital of the Corporation is Rs.300.00 crores and paid up capital is Rs.299.99 crores.

MISSION

The mission of NSKFDC is to empower the Safai Karamcharis, Scavengers and their dependents to break away from traditional occupation, depressed social conditions, poverty and leverage them to work their own way up the social and economic ladder with dignity and pride.

OBJECTIVES

To promote socio-economic upliftment of Safai Karamcharis and their dependents by way of providing financial assistance at concessional rate of interest for income generating activities and loans to students for pursuing professional and technical education.

To provide technical and professional training for Skill Development of the target group.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A Scavenger/Safai Karamchari and their dependents duly identified under the NSLRS/survey/registered co-operative society of Safai Karamcharis/legally constituted association/firm promoted by the target group and also all those who produce a certificate from local Revenue Officer/local Municipal Officer/Cantonment Executive Officer/Railway Officer, Head of the Govt. Departments (i.e. Schools, Colleges, Forest, Health, Education, Animal Husbandry having rank not less than Gazetted Officer), Elected Members of Municipal Body/ Corporation & Pradhan of Gram Panchayats.

Scavenger means and includes a Safai Karamchari wholly or partially employed for manual handling of human excreta and includes his dependents.

Safai Karamchari means a person engaged in or employed for any sanitation work and includes his dependents.

Dependents in relation to a Safai Karamcharis or a Scavengers means and includes a member of his family who is dependent on him and attained the age of 18 years & above and for Skill Development Training Programme the age limit is 17 years to 40 years.

As per Lending Policy & Guidelines (LPG) of NSKFDC, an eligible identified person of the target group can avail the benefit of schemes of NSKFDC at one time only.

TYPES OF LOAN

Term loan - Term loan upto 90% of the projects costing upto Rs.10.00 lacs including sanitation-based equipments is given. The balance 10% is to be provided by the State Channelising Agencies (SCAs) as margin money including subsidy alongwith promoter's contribution.

Promoters contribution not to be insisted upto project cost of Rs.2.00 lacs and beyond Rs.2.00 lacs, minimum promoters contribution to be insisted would be 5%.

No income limit is fixed for availing financial assistance.

Rate of Interest:-

NSKFDC to SCA		3%
SCA to beneficiary	not exceeding	6%

Repayment period - Loan shall be repaid within 5 years after moratorium period of 6 months.

Micro Credit Finance (MCF) - Micro Credit Finance (MCF) is provided for small/petty trade/business & sundry income generating activities upto 90% of the cost of the projects upto Rs.5.00 lacs restricted to Rs.30,000/- per beneficiary and balance is provided by SCAs.

Rate of Interest :-

NSKFDC to SCA		2%
SCA to beneficiary	not exceeding	5%

Repayment period :- The loan shall be repaid within a period of 3 years after moratorium of 6 months.

Mahila Samridhi Yojana (MSY) - Loan under Mahila Samridhi Yojana is provided to Women Safai Karamcharis and Scavenger women and their dependent daughters upto Rs.30,000/- per beneficiary at an interest rate of 1% from NSKFDC to SCA and 4% from SCA to beneficiary.

Mahila Adhikarita Yojana (MAY) - Loan under Mahila Adhikarita Yojana is provided to Women Safai Karamcharis and Scavenger and their dependent daughters upto Rs.50,000/- per beneficiary at an interest rate of 2% from NSKFDC to SCA and 5% from SCA to beneficiary.

EDUCATION LOAN

Education loan is extended to the members of Safai Karamcharis including Scavengers and their dependents for pursuing professional or technical education at graduate and post-graduate level and also for higher study in Engineering, Medical, Management, Law, Diploma in Physiotherapy, Pathology, Nursing, Diploma in Hotel Management & Tourism, Geriatric Care & Academic courses at Graduate & Post Graduate level like Bachelor of Education, Ph. D., Language Courses, BCA, MCA, Diploma in Journalism & Mass Communication etc. to the extent of 90% of the expenditure of the course subject to maximum loan limit of Rs.10.00 lacs for study in India and Rs.20.00 lac for study in abroad or Rs.2.50 lac (India) and Rs.5.00 lac (Abroad) per annum. The balance 10% will be borne by student/SCA.

SCHEMES/PROJECTS UPTO RS. 1.00 LAC

The SCA may draw funds from NSKFDC based on the schemes/Projects in the annual action plan for schemes/projects already approved by NSKFDC for the SCA concerned and approved schemes/contained in the compendium of NSKFDC.

TRAINING

Training is imparted to the eligible members of the target group between the age group of 17-40 for self employment ventures and skill development for taking up income generating activities in Industry, Services & Business sectors in the form of 100% grant. The grant amount also includes the stipend amount of Rs.1000/- per month /per candidate.

TYPES OF TRAINING

Institutional linkage programmes (ILP) is a training programme under which the eligible candidates sponsored by the SCAs are given training in specialized traded for a period of one to six months with stipend and boarding in reputed training institutes in the country.

Skill up-gradation Training Programme (STP) is a training programme under which practicing craftsmen/artisans are given training for skill upgradation to equip them to the changing market demands. Normally the training is non-residential and the duration of training is 10 days to 2 months.

Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) is a training programme for imparted skills and knowledge to the beneficiaries to equip them to set up their own business. The duration of the training is 10 days to 3 months and normally the programme is non-residential.
