

Background

National Safai Karamcharis Finance & Development Corporation (NSKFDC) is a wholly owned Govt. of India Undertaking under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, set up on 24th January 1997 as a Company "Not for Profit" under Section 8 of the Companies Act, 2013. It is in operation since October, 1997, as an Apex Corporation for the all round socio-economic upliftment of the Safai Karamcharis (including wastepickers), Manual Scavengers and their dependants throughout the Country through its various loan and non-loan based schemes. The loan schemes are implemented through State Channelizing Agencies (SCAs) nominated by the State Govts./UTs/Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) & Public Sector Banks (PSBs) and Skill Development Training Programmes (SDTP) are implemented through Govt. Sector Training Institutions across the Country.

Revised Self Employment Scheme of Rehabilitation of Manual Scavengers (SRMS):

Eligibility: Manual Scavengers identified during the survey conducted in States/UTs as per MS Act-2013.

- 1) One Time Cash Assistance (OTCA) of Rs.40,000/- (one person in a family).
- 2) Capital Subsidy for beneficiaries from the category of Manual Scavengers.
